## **Party Information**

- Parties are scheduled year-round, by appointment only.
- Scheduling depends on party coordinator availability and dates sometimes fill up quickly, so we ask that you schedule parties at least two weeks in advance.
- Weekend parties are held on Saturday and Sunday from 10:00 am- 5:00 pm.
- Weekday parties are held on Monday-Friday from 4:00 8:30 pm.
- To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all guests and our animals, birthday parties have a maximum attendance limit of 20 people (including both children and adults). If the total number of attendees exceeds this limit, an additional \$50 fee will be applied to accommodate the extra guests. This fee helps cover the additional staffing, space, and resources required to ensure the comfort and safety of everyone participating.
- Food and drinks are not supplied by the Humane Society, but you are welcome to bring pizza, cake, goodies, drinks, decorations, etc. at your own expense.
- Parents are welcome to set up the party space 30 minutes prior to the party start time.
- Balloons and other decorations are allowed, but nothing is to be affixed to the walls of the party room.
  NO PINATAS PLEASE.
- Minimum donation of \$275 is required and includes services of a Party Coordinator, educational talk, tour of the adoption center and interaction with appropriate cats and dogs.
- A liability waiver must be completed by each attendee's parent or guardian for the child to attend the party.
