

Letter from West Suburban Humane Society's Executive Director



On behalf of myself, the Board of Directors, staff and volunteers, I want to thank you for your continued support of the West Suburban Humane Society (WSHS). In 2015, WSHS celebrated 43 years of helping animals in need. I am proud to have been a part of this great organization for the past 16 years as executive director and 27 years as a volunteer.

Our adoptions continue to grow year after year. Last year we adopted a record 807 animals into their forever homes. All of these animals were spayed/neutered and microchipped before leaving the shelter. This is a big step toward our goal of preventing pet overpopulation and reuniting lost pets with their owners.

One of my lifelong dreams was realized when we were able to hire a part-time humane education manager. Through her leadership, we have implemented seven presentations that can be tailored to academic and social needs with collaboration from the classroom teacher or group leader, shelter tours, after

school programs for kids of all ages, five weeks of Junior Volunteer Summer Camp and Party Pals. This is an important step in achieving our mission of educating children in the humane treatment of all animals.

More than 500 dedicated volunteers contributed more than 37,000 hours of service to help animals in need. Our STAR training program improved dog behavior and dramatically shortened shelter stay; and our foster care homes gave the smallest and sickest ones their chances for survival and healthy lives. Staff and volunteers teamed up to save more lives and to strengthen our organizational commitment to finding animals their forever homes.

I want to extend a heartfelt thank you to our supporters who generously contributed in 2015. We couldn't do what we do without your help and generosity. Your donation truly does save lives!

About WSHS

West Suburban Humane Society (WSHS) is a volunteer-based, animal welfare organization that was founded in 1972 as a lost and found referral service. We provide housing for up to 25 dogs and 60 cats at a time. We operate at full capacity at all times with animal care and adoptions being provided by 2 full-time and 6 part-time employees and nearly 500 volunteers. Our facility is open to the public 6 days a week. We continue to reunite lost animals and their owners by maintaining a database with information on over 33,000 pets and their owners, and by providing free pet identification tags to all pet owners.

Mission

WSHS is dedicated to operating a premier animal shelter for the purpose of finding safe, permanent and compatible homes to adopt domestic dogs and cats. We are committed to educating and encouraging the public to humanely care for dogs and cats.

Vision

WSHS will achieve and sustain its reputation for being the premier humane organization in Illinois. To achieve such recognition, WSHS will focus on the following critical components:

Advocacy: WSHS will promote the humane care of dogs and cats by working with government agencies and other agencies to promote the humane care of animals.

Care: WSHS will be the preeminent provider of animal care, working with high quality veterinarians to provide the most appropriate medical treatment for non-terminal conditions of cats and dogs in our care. Further, WSHS will develop innovative practices, such as working with reputable trainers in the area to ensure that every animal in our care receives the best total care before being adopted by the most compatible owner.

Education: WSHS will educate our staff, volunteers and members of the community on proper pet health care and safety. We will provide ample information and constant support to our adoptive families and act as an invaluable resource for educating the public at large.

Fundraising: WSHS will remain financially solvent and transparent so that we can continue to focus on finding new sources of revenue and maintaining our relationship with those who have provided financial contributions.



WSHS Success Stories

Heifer – A Life Saving Surgery

Heifer was one of six babies born to mom Oreo. All seemed fine until she reached about 10 weeks of age. That was when her foster mom noticed that Heifer seemed lethargic and wasn't able to keep up with the rest of the puppies in her litter. Heifer was taken to the vet and diagnosed with a condition called PDA (Patent Ductus Arteriosus). This is a condition where a duct that closes at birth fails to do so and the results can be fatal. In order to correct this problem she needed to have surgery at U of I in Urbana, IL. Without surgery, most puppies die at a very young age. We needed to act soon if we expected a good outcome.

Yes, there were six puppies in this litter, so why save this one? Because that is what we do. How could we turn our backs on this little baby? Heifer is a loving, sweet puppy who would live a normal dog's life as long as she got this critical surgery. Many shelters would simply euthanize a puppy with a congenital conditional such as this, but that is not our way. Every life matters and Heifer never signed up for a life-threatening condition. The good thing about PDA is that once it is fixed, the dog is expected to live a long and normal life. That is all we wished for little Heifer, a chance at a healthy life and a forever home. Through the generosity of our supporters, Heifer was able to have the surgery and has made a full recovery. She has also been lucky enough to find her forever home.



Rocky - Against All Odds

A total stranger walked into our shelter this past July holding a cardboard box with a 4-week-old kitten inside. He was cowering in the grass, cold, hungry and alone. He'd been abandoned by his mother, was severely underweight, and breathed in low, deep rasps. At another shelter, this might have been the end of Rocky's story.



The staff rushed Rocky to the vet where he was put in an incubator and given fluids and antibiotics. After X-rays and blood work we discovered he had pectus excavatum, a genetic condition that could require surgery as he grows. At another shelter this might have been the end of Rocky's story.

Instead Rocky spent several days at the vet and was eating, gaining weight and thrilling his cheering section at the shelter. He got well enough to go to an experienced foster home where he stayed for two weeks until he suddenly stopped eating. He lost most of the weight he'd gained and we didn't know what was wrong. We took him back to the vet where he was diagnosed with a diaphragmatic hernia and given a 50/50 chance of surviving surgery. At any other shelter, that might be the end of Rocky's story.

We sent him to a surgeon who discovered he didn't have a hernia after all but had gastroenteritis. He needed IV fluids, medication and antibiotics for two weeks.

Today Rocky is sleek, thriving and enjoying life in his forever home. The joy he brings to everyone he meets more than justifies the cost of his care. Without the gifts our supporters give to the shelter each year, Rocky's story would have had a very different ending. We never turn our backs on an animal in need, no matter how great the cost, but we need your help to continue our mission.

Veterinary care costs our shelter more than \$50,000 each year, and that's with the generous discounts our partner vets are able to provide. Pet food and animal care, all add up to more than \$200,000 annually.

In addition, WSHS is planning for a new shelter. Our building is old and was not designed as a shelter, and though we do the best we can with what we have, our mission is to operate a premier animal shelter, giving our animals, volunteers and adopters the best experience we can. While we operate on a very tight budget, several generous gifts have provided seed money to begin exploring shelter plans and construction designs.

Before we can commit to such a large project, however, we need to ensure all our current needs can be met. Our first responsibility is to our animals, and as we look to the future we must maintain the present. Your gift to the WSHS -- whether an annual gift, a monthly donation, a corporate sponsorship or a legacy gift -- will save lives right now, and ensures that our mission of caring for homeless dogs and cats continues.

What Makes WSHS Special

In 2011, WSHS was able to recognize one of our biggest dreams. We remodeled our cattery and went from cats living in cages to cats enjoying a spacious, open cattery. Since opening the cattery, our cat adoptions have increased by 5%. Outbreaks of upper respiratory and other feline illnesses have decreased by almost 50% The cats are happier, healthier and more adoptable!

In 2007, WSHS founded one of our most important programs, the STAR (Special Training and Reinforcement) program. The STAR program sends dogs with behavioral problems to camp. The problems can range from difficult-to-handle or aggression to shyness and overall confidence building. Many animals have been neglected and abused and have developed negative behaviors to help them cope. The program allows dogs a smoother transition to successful adoption placement. In addition, the quick transition helps to free up available space for other animals needing to be placed up for adoption.

In 2015, WSHS was able to hire a part time Humane Education Manager. Since that time we have implemented 7 presentations that can be tailored to academic and social needs with collaboration from the classroom teacher or group leader; shelter tours; after school programs for kids of all ages; 5 weeks of Junior Volunteer Summer Camp; and Party Pals.

At WSHS, a dedicated staff, volunteer base and the retained service of several veterinarians has allowed us to save the lives of and place over 600 homeless animals each year into new homes. Every animal that is brought to our shelter receives whatever type of veterinary care that is needed, including surgery and hospitalization for trauma cases, long-term care and medication for viral and bacterial infections, and treatment of parasite infestations such as heartworm. Orphaned kittens and puppies as well as the infirm receive loving care in our Temporary Care Homes until they are ready for adoption.


